The Assessment Only Route recognises the experience that unqualified teachers have gained during their professional career.

If you already have a degree, and significant teaching experience, then you can achieve QTS (Qualified Teacher Status) in as little as one term, through the AO (Assessment Only) Route.

ENTRY CRITERIA:

- All entrants have achieved a standard equivalent to a grade 4/grade C in GCSE English and mathematics.
- All those who intend to teach pupils aged 3 to 11 additionally have achieved a standard equivalent to a grade 4/grade C in a GCSE science subject.
- Hold a first degree* of a United Kingdom Higher Education Institution or equivalent qualification.
- Passed the Professional Skills Tests in Literacy and Numeracy prior to commencement of the assessment period.
- Have taught in at least two schools, early years and/or further education settings
- Have taken part in a selection process designed to assess suitability to teach and the ability to demonstrate meeting all the standards for QTS without the need for any further training.

**A first degree comprises 300 HE credit points of which 60 must be at level 6 of the QCF.*
